#### Top Picks:

- **Filevine** → Best for case-heavy firms with custom process flows

- **Smokeball** → Excellent for document automation + staff accountability
- **MyCase** → User-friendly + solid billing features

#### Watch out for:

- ✗ Poor reporting dashboards
  - ✗ Tools that don't assign task ownership clearly

### ✔ If You're Focused on Marketing + Lead Nurturing

📌 Goal: Automated follow-ups, lead conversion, pipeline tracking

#### Top Picks:

- **Lawmatics** → Best-in-class for nurturing and email/SMS follow-ups
- **Clio Grow** → Clean pipeline with integrations to Manage
- **Uptime Practice** → Great for cloud-based intake with security focus

#### Watch out for:

- ✗ CRMs with no true "pipeline" view
  - ✗ Systems that can't automate multi-step journeys
